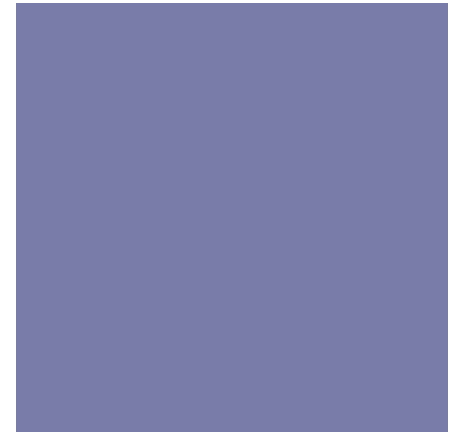
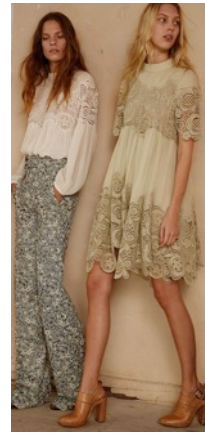






## Isabelle

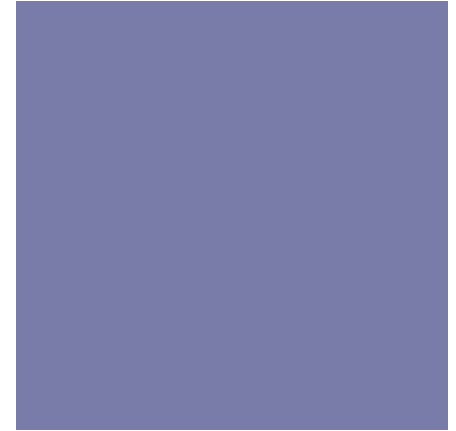

Emily

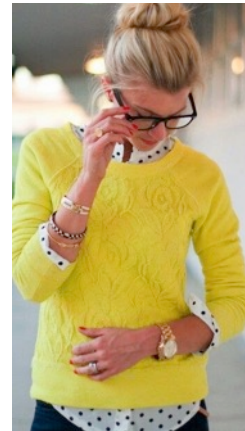
Singer, strong beliefs, expectations, cute, trendy, trying too hard, and then relaxes

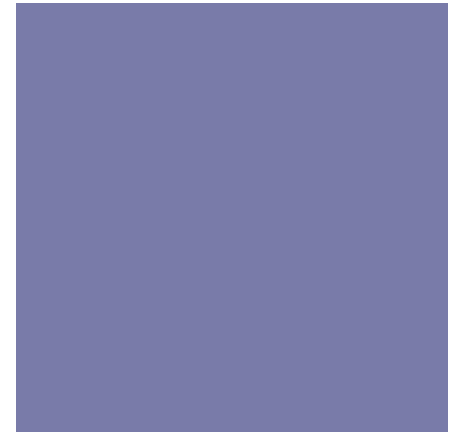
Try flap dress, front or handheld camera, nerdy, business, roommates start to rub off on each other—borrow each others clothes? (Emily)





## Evelyn

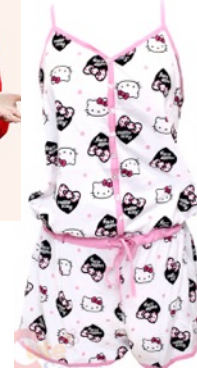
Sexual, party style. Leader, shows how things should be done, uptight and repressed. More covered when most vulnerable—monologue.





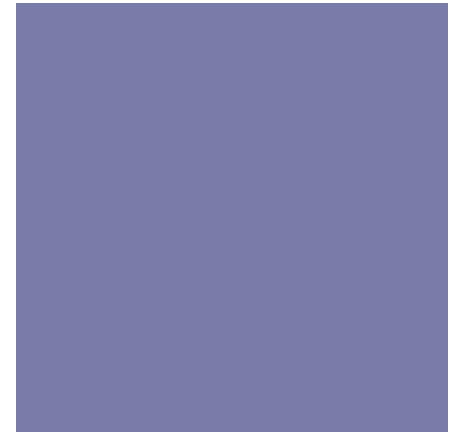

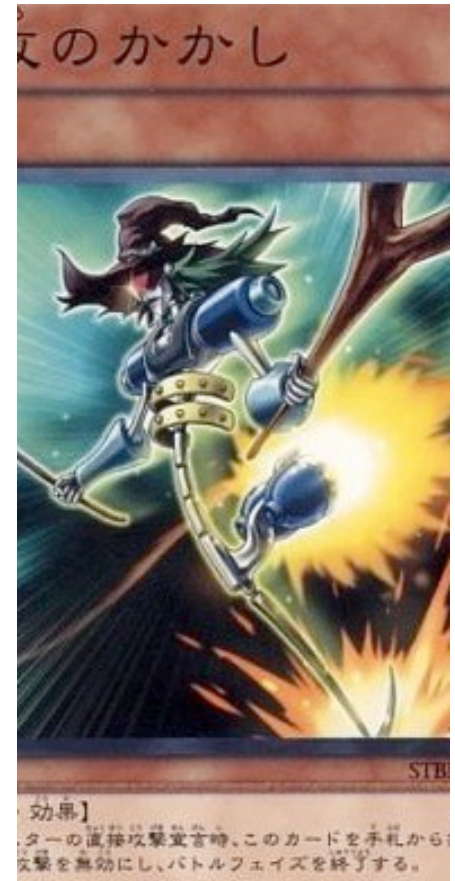
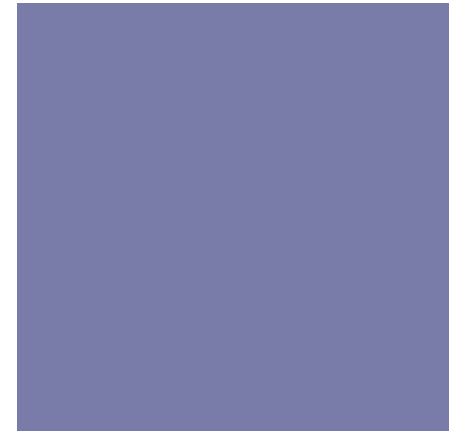


# KUEBIKO

Kuebiko is a scarecrow who has the characteristics of both being very wise, and unable to move.

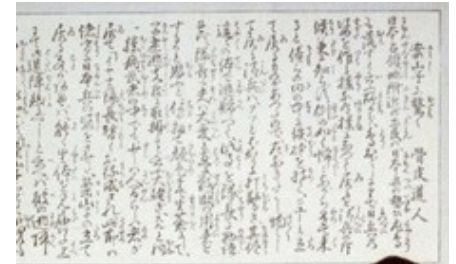
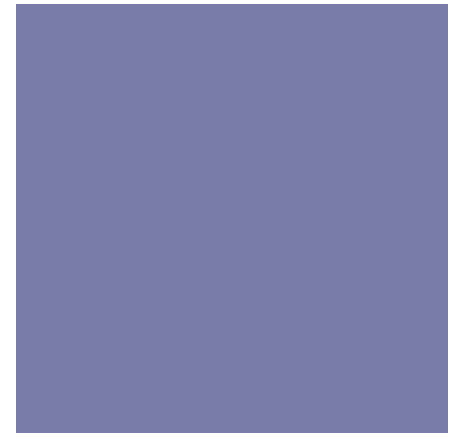

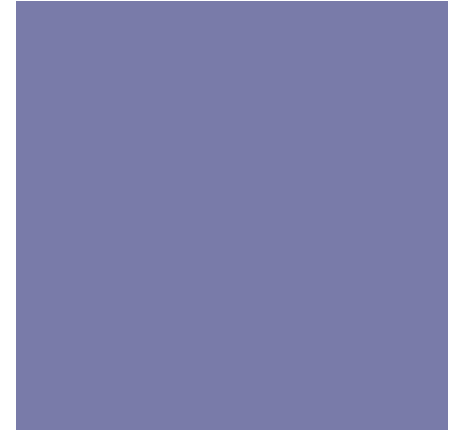
# Slenderman
